ABOUT THE TRAINING

Who is this course for?

ImprovWise is a training course for trainers, facilitators, youth workers, youth leaders, educators and teachers, who actively work with groups of young people, and intend to apply improvisational theatre and use improvisation techniques in a more conscious way.

What will you do for 5 days?

5 full working days will be devoted to train improvisation techniques and experience impro scenes focusing on specific topics in each session, e.g. presence, connection, trust, spontaneity, flexibility, risk, mistakes, creativity, characters and storytelling. The sessions will be adapted to the needs of the group.

OUR APPROACH

Improv exercises are often perceived as fun games and energisers. Improvisational theatre is a more complex non-formal educational methodology than a series of joyful exercises. It teaches us a high level of cooperation, offers a wide range of opportunities for skills and personal development and is entertaining at the same time. Positive attitude is the way how we approach this method, because it creates a comfortable, safe environment and solid grounds for collective creativity. We are encouraged to take risks and often bravely make mistakes.

OUTCOME

During the training you will explore

- the principles of improvisational theatre
- inspiration and trust in the partner in scenes
- active presence and high level of attention
- positive attitude and acceptance
- balancing between flexibility and decisiveness
- spontaneity and thinking „inside the box“
- developing characters
- storytelling & improvisation

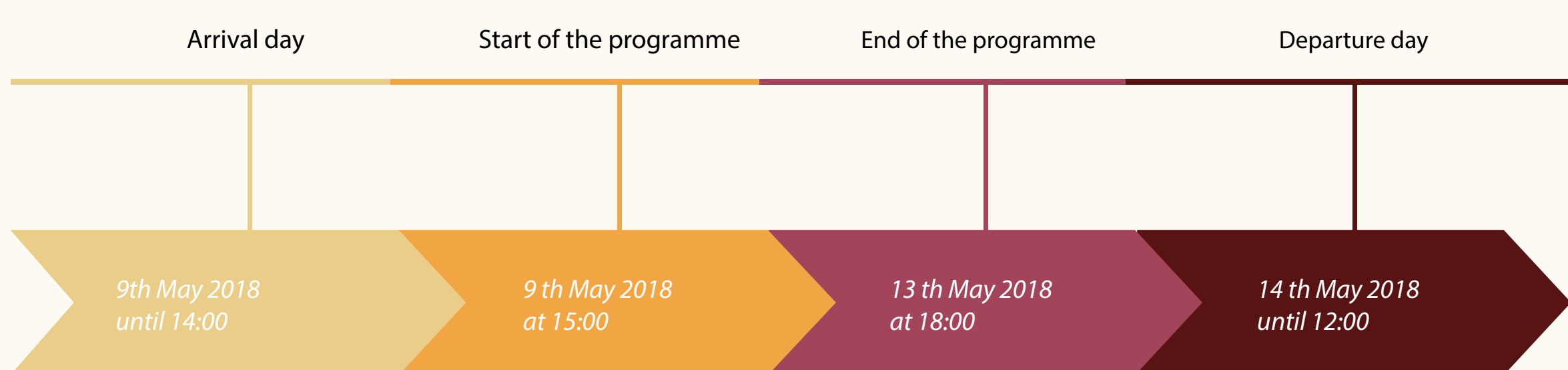
What can you get out of it?

- taking risks and welcoming mistakes as crucial elements of one's learning cycle
- reducing anxiety and increasing your self-confidence
- unlocking your creativity
- developing soft skills e.g. active listening, problem solving
- improvisation techniques, games and exercises in youth work and training for e.g. group dynamics, team building, skills development exercises
- learning about improvisers' mindset

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

Course Details

The ImproWise training consists of 5 working days, 6 to 8 hours of activities and practice each day, which is adapted to the needs of the group.



Accommodation

During the training you are hosted in Creative Space Training Centre www.kreativ-ter.hu. The hosting accommodation is in UNESCO World Heritage village Hollókő. (www.holloko.hu) Hosting and catering will be provided within this accommodation. There is a wireless internet connection in the house that you can use. There are 4 bedded sleeping rooms, each room has its shower and toilet.



Language

The training is given in simple and easy-to-understand English.

Trainers

Gergő Kiss has been a Trainer in both profit and non-profit sectors since 2009. He has trained improvisation with Grund Theatre in Budapest since 2014, attended Impro Master Classes with Keith Johnstone. He worked with Jim Libby (US) and Colleen Doyle (US). His special fields are improvisation, creativity and interpersonal communication.

Lucie Vokrouhliková has been involved in improvisational theatre groups for over 6 years, trained by professional improvisers from various countries, e.g. Lee White (CA), Omar Galvan (ARG) and attended Impro Master Classes with Keith Johnstone in Berlin and Denmark. Currently, both Gergő and Lucie are part of Grund Theatre Lab trained by Andrew Hefler.



Training fee is

290 € for people with paid jobs
240 € for students and people with no paid jobs.

The fee covers the following costs:

- accommodation in an UNESCO World Heritage site for 5 nights
- food according to your dietary needs
- rental of a training room with high quality equipment
- training materials

It does not cover the travel costs, visa and insurance.

This training is not funded by Erasmus+ or any other grant.
