Summary

This Training Course will bring together professionals, youth workers and organisations invested in tackling racism and radicalization. Through a series of lectures, activities and events the participants will become better agents of social change, situated within a stronger network.

Aim

This Training Course aims to empower participants to become active in the fight against Racism & Radicalization. By the end of the course, the participants will not only have fostered greater tolerance but have become better agents to enact social change. Participants will leave with stronger relationships with other European organisations creating the potential for future projects.

Objectives

- Develop participants competence to speak publicly on issues regarding racism and radicalization
- To provide participants with the skills and tools needed to tackle racism and radicalization.
- To create international cooperation between professionals from numerous countries
- To share best practice in order to heighten the quality of anti-racism and anti-radicalization initiatives.

How will the aims and objectives be achieved?

Over the course of 5 Days. The participants will debate, brainstorm, discuss, and analyse amongst themselves. Their experience will be complemented with excursions, videos, and meetings with other organisations who are also involved in work surrounding racism and radicalization. This will provide an ideal environment for experience sharing and the opportunity to find future partners.

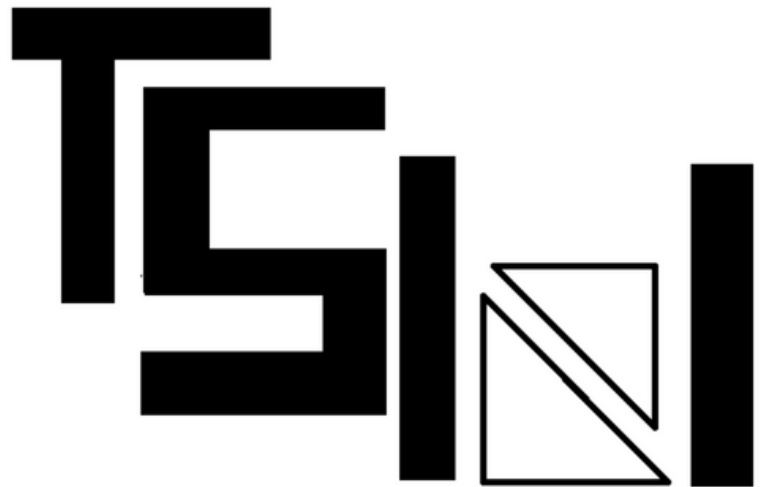

Travel Information

Participants should arrive at Bristol Airport prior to **3pm** on the 11th of November. From there, you will be picked up and driven to the accommodation where you will be staying for the duration of the training course. On arrival food will be awaiting you.

For the Departure, it's best to depart in the Evening of the 15th of November (prior to **6pm**). You will be accomodated back to Bristol Airport.

The training course begins with participants arriving on the 11th of November, spending 5 days participating on the training. Before departing on the 15th of November. If you seek to stay longer or shorter, please contact us and we can assist you in your stay.

Accomodation

Staying in Accomodation close to the Historical British City of Bristol. Those who are confirmed will be told the exact place. Participants should be comfortable sharing a room, sexes will not be mixed.

What to bring?

- A good attitude, willing to participate in group activities and challenge ideas
- Information about yourself, your organisation, and/or your work surrounding racism and/or radicalization
- Bring an item of your food for the cultural evening, the type of food does not matter but one with a national story would be great.
- The UK can be quite cold, check your local weather, then check it to the weather in the UK and appropriately prepare thick clothing.

Preparation for the Training Program

Bring examples of racism and radicalization which have taken place in your country. These can be things which have been said by politicians, events, or attacks These will be discussed and analysed at a point during the training program.
