- Hosting organization: International Foundation for Y-PEER Development
- Target group: 27 youth peer educators and youth workers
 residing in Ukraine, Albania, Lebanon, Portugal, Italy, Germany,
 Turkiye, Palestine and Bulgaria (three participants per country)
- Venue: Ivana Palace Hotel, Sunny Beach, Bulgaria (21–28 June 2023) & Kitchen 59, Sofia, Bulgaria (only on 20 and 28 June 2023)
- Dates: 20th 29th June
- **Expenses:** Visa cost, flight tickets, local transportation from Sofia to the Venue, and accommodation are covered by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union.
- Extended Deadline: 25th April, 2023



The International Foundation for Y-PEER Development (IFYD) is calling for youth peer educators and youth workers from the participating countries to join an International Training Course "Care to Act" that will take place in Bulgaria between 20–29 June 2023.



Project Background Ly

The training will bring together a group of 27 youth peer educators and youth workers from different countries and background from "Ukraine, Albania, Lebanon, Portugal, Italy, Germany, Turkiye, and Palestine and Bulgaria" with different social, economic, cultural backgrounds and different living situations, in order to create a space for intercultural exchange and mutual learning.

The main idea of "Care to Act" Training Course is to develop the capacities for the youth peer educators and youth workers from the partner countries towards participation in decision-making processes and create peer-education sessions for their own communities in order to achieve a democratic restructuring of society in the face of a variety of social and oppressive issues, including Gender-based Violence, Stigma & Discrimination, Bullying and Racism.



Expected Outcomes

- Building four Interactive— Community theater pieces tackling oppression themes related to Gender Based Violence, Stigma & Discrimination, Bullying and Racism.
 Each theatrical piece will present one of the mentioned themes.
- Develop youth knowledge on human rights, active citizenship, conflict resolution, communication and teamwork skills.



- Develop participants' capacities to design and implement awareness sessions with their organizations using Interactive and Community based theater techniques.
- Develop youth potential to create their own theater performances dealing with different social issues, as well as developing their tools with non-formal education strategies.

Who Are We?

The International Foundation for Y-PEER Development (IFYD) is a non-profit organization created in 2016 in Bulgaria, and is based on the experience of the professionals and volunteers at the International Institute for Youth Development PETRI-Sofia (www.petri-sofia.org), which has more than 13 years of experience working for young people's development and empowerment.

IFYD supports the global Y-PEER youth network, which is active in 50 countries around the world. It aims to empower young people by focusing on their sexual and reproductive health and rights, gender equality, youth participation, civic engagement, advocacy, and peacebuilding.



Eligibility Criteria & - & - W

Participating Countries: Ukraine, Albania, Lebanon, Portugal, Italy, Germany, Turkiye, Palestine and Bulgaria.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Aged 18+
- Resident in one of the participating countries of the project
- Available for the whole period (20-29 June 2023)
- Have the experience in working with organizations on programs/projects for youth and advanced knowledge in non-formal education



 Have previously engaged in working for the topics of the projects or interested to work on Gender Equality, Gender Based Violence (GBV), Combating Taboos, Stigma and Discrimination affecting vulnerable groups, Peacebuilding and Conflict Resolution through interactive theatre techniques

 Be open to learning, developing new skills, acquiring knowledge related to non-formal educational methods and working with disadvantaged groups

 Able to engage a group in an educational process, appreciate an interactive model of learning, create a comfortable environment, convey accurate information, mediate conflict and understand group dynamics

After we send you email of invitation, you will be kindly requested to apply for the Bulgarian visa if needed at the nearest Bulgarian embassy to your city, and book your flight/train/bus tickets to Bulgaria and back home. Please note, the costs will be reimbursed to you in Bulgaria up to the limit (please check the cost limit on page 15)

Extended Deadline: 25 April 2023 at midnight Sofia time!

Practical Information & Accommodation



- Official language of the International training course is English.
- Travel expenses from your home country to Bulgaria, and back will be reimbursed once you are in Bulgaria, within the limit that European Union calculated for participants from your country based on presented original tickets and boarding passes.
- Please be aware that the bus ride from Sofia to Sunny Beach takes around 6 hours, and the round-trip fare is about 40 EUR (this cost is included in your total traveling budget).
- You can also travel directly to Sunny Beach without coming to Sofia. In this case, you search for flights to (Burgas Airport) on 21 June to 28 June 2023.

Practical Information & Accommodation



- There will be a Wi-Fi Internet available in the Venue.
- On 20 June day of Arrival and 29 June, you will be staying in Sofia at <u>Kitchen 59</u> hotel.
- The training course will take place in Ivana Palace, Sunny Beach. You can check the hotel through their website; https://ivanapalace.eu/
- Your stay in Ivana Palace, Sunny Beach will take place between the 21th and the 28th of June 2023 and you will be given with full board accommodation, breakfast, lunch, dinner, coffee breaks, and training facilities.
- Please keep in mind that you will be sharing a room with another person of the same gender.

Reimbursement

The organizers will reimburse you according to the limit for travel costs for each participant, based on presented original tickets and boarding passes. If your travel costs are lower or the same as this amount, you get the reimbursement 100% of your real travel costs. If your travel costs are higher, then you will have to cover the amount exceeding the limit. Visa cost will also be covered based on the table on page 15.

Please note that the travel costs will be reimbursed in cash in Bulgarian leva during the Training Course. You will have the opportunity to exchange to EUR or another currency in Sofia.















Youth Pass
