- discover the power of visual creativity in youth work, both as a method and as a goal in itself;
- **learn** about visual support in the learning process with respect to the topic of accessibility and learning styles;
- **become** more self-confident in graphic facilitation and creativity.

Participants profile

We are looking for 21 participants:

- at least 18 years old;
- able to communicate in English and work in a multicultural context;
- being an active youth worker / NGO worker / teacher or looking to work with Youth in the future;
- with a valid residence permit in one of the organizations' countries (see Partners section);
- interested in the topic of **graphic facilitation**;
- motivated and excited to learn :)
- being present during all the parts of the project (preparation, activity, dissemination);
- ready to use the acquired competences after the activity in dissemination and **follow-up** activities.



Accommodation

The project will take place in **Hotel Las Cruces**, located in the lovely town of **Belmonte de Miranda** (Asturias region, Northern Spain).

We will be staying in **double rooms** equipped with all comforts (towels and soap will be provided by the hotel).

We will have **3 meals** and **2 coffee/tea breaks** each day. We will send the selected participants a specific form to fill out with dietary requirements, allergies or any needs. Here are some useful links:

Reimbursement

How does it work?

Before the training course, you will have to purchase your tickets to travel to Spain. During the activity, we will collect all the receipts and tickets, sign a reimbursement contract and, once the dissemination is completed, send you the transfer back.



Important:

- Only tickets approved before the activity by the hosting organization will be reimbursed
- Remember to keep all your receipts and tickets
- You have to participate in all the sessions of the training to get the reimbursement

Dissemination



What to expect after the training course:

Every participant involved is expected to collaborate with the teammates and the sending organization to **produce an article** about the project's activities and their impressions. This article should be presented on the website or social media of the partner organisation respective to their country.

Within **two months** of the training course each participant, individually or in teams, should arrange **follow-up workshops** focused on the training topic. Partner organizations will support them in the process.

Please note that the reimbursement process will not begin until the dissemination phase has been completed.

Once selected...

Once the selection of participants is completed, you will receive:

- The programme of the activities and some tasks will help you to become more prepared for the training course;
- Some **practical information** (how to get there, weather, currency etc);
- A complete list of what to bring will help you come prepared;
- A form where you can share with us your dietary requirements, other preferences and emergency contacts;
- An invitation for the **Facebook group** of the project, where we will start getting in touch with everyone.

VERY IMPORTANT: Please, before applying to this project, take into consideration that this is a non-formal **learning activity** financed by public money. We are looking for motivated participants, willing to work on the **program for 6/7 hours daily**.
