

LOCATION & TIMEFRAME



India is the second largest English speaking nation in the world, behind USA and most preferred destination for English language teachers. Teaching in India will give you international teaching experience and exposure to a different educational system, curriculum and teaching methods.



Indian educational system comprises of Primary, Secondary and Higher secondary.

Usually classes start at 9.00 AM and end at 3.00 PM. In between, children have free time for break and lunch.

Schools are administered through government or private sectors.

The curriculum of India schools is a mixture of State/ CBSE/ICSE syllabus which is a choice open to students.

There are 18 official and 96 unofficial languages in India. A 1st grade child (6 yo) studies state (Malayalam), national (Hindi) language and English along with subjects like mathematics, social studies, science, arts, computer science, moral science etc

This sets apart the Indian educational system as unique in the world. In some schools children have the option to select a foreign language (mostly French and German) as their optional third language.

Indian teachers occupy an elated status in the society. Teachers are highly respected in the society as torch bearers of divine knowledge and responsible for moulding India's future generation. In Indian society children are taught to respect their parents first and then their teachers. In the status of hierarchy the teachers are second to parents. Children are indoctrinated to imbibe the Indian philosophy of Matha, Pitha, Guru, Daivam, (Mother, Father, Teacher, God).
